Rules and Regulations

Deadline: All applications must be received by MONDAY, JUNE 22, 2009

Purpose: The purpose of the annual Laramie Jubilee Days Parade is to further the promotion and celebration of Wyoming’s statehood through Laramie and Albany County’s annual Jubilee Days celebration. The following rules are established by the Board of Directors to maintain the purpose and integrity of the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade.

Entrants: All entrants in the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade are encouraged to develop plans for an entry that promote the purpose and theme of the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade

General Theme: The general theme of Jubilee Days is western and includes the western heritage of our community and our state.

Specific Theme: Each year, the Board of Directors determines a specific theme for the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade for entries to focus upon which is primary and in addition to the general theme. This year the specific theme of Jubilee Days Parade is A Salute to the Western Volunteer.

Description and Specific Requirements

All parade entries, except clowns, bands, military units, colorful performing and marching groups shall be western and related to the above theme, unless otherwise approved by the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade and Committee.

All riders shall be required to wear appropriate western attire; boots, hats, long-sleeve shirts, historical attire for women. Lone riders will not be permitted, but will be teamed with another rider or group.

All applications for entry are subject to the approval of, and acceptance by the parade committee. Any entry application which may be categorized as described in Paragraph 4 herein shall be considered “suspect” and subject to scrutiny and decision of the approval or disapproval by the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade Committee. All decisions of the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade Committee are final.

All entries must be in place by 9:00 a.m. on the morning of the parade
Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. in the staging area

Results of the judging will be announced and awards given out following the parade.

General Rules

1. All units entered in the parade must have identification of the sponsor/owner in legible, neat and easy to read signs or banners fastened securely to the side of the entry.
2. All units shall have the entry number on both sides. Your entry number will be sent to you with your entry confirmation, but the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade Committee **will not provide numbers to display on your entry.** Display your number in an obvious, easy to find area for the judges and the radio station play by play.
3. Any religious organization or group, social group, political group, political party or current office holder, public or private commercial enterprise or any other person, group or entry that makes an entry application which is by its purpose or theme or otherwise would tend to express or promote any purpose, belief or social cause **not having substantial relation to the general theme or specific theme of the Laramie Jubilee Days Parade may not be allowed entry approval.**
4. There shall be no individuals or groups 12 years of age or younger on foot in the parade. Any exceptions to this rule are limited strictly to decision and discretion of Laramie Jubilee Days Parade Committee.
5. All political candidates will ride with their parties, no individual entries will be taken.
6. Private parking lots or driveways near the staging area may not be used by parade participants for preparation without prior approval of the property owner.

<h3>SAFETY RULES</h3>

1. **There shall be no discharge of firearms, firecrackers or similar devices within 500 yards of any part of the parade.**
2. **ABSOLUTELY NO OBJECTS (CANDY, BALLOONS, GUM ETC.) SHALL BE THROWN FROM FLOATS, VEHICLES OR OTHER ENTRIES. For safety's sake, these may be handed out along the route by walking clowns or persons in costume.**
3. **THERE SHALL BE NO WATER GUNS, WATER BALLOONS, FIRE HOSES OR WATER OF ANY KIND DISCHARGED FROM THE PARADE ENTRY. Any discharge of water from an entry will result in the entry being removed from the parade.**
4. **Parade marshals shall have the authority to remove any entry for safety reasons.**
5. **Parade marshals shall have the authority to make any last minute changes in the lineup for safety and emergency factors. Entrants with teams shall be responsible for spectator and participant safety-outriders are required. (Persons with unruly horses may be removed)**
6. **There shall be no loss of forward motion during the parade.**
